The men's major golf championships, commonly known as the Major Championships, and often referred to simply as the majors, are the four most prestigious annual tournaments in professional golf. In order of play date, they are: April – Masters Tournament (weekend ending 2nd Sunday in April) – hosted by Augusta National Golf Club. The PGA Championship moved to CBS in 1995 and the U.S. Open returned.
